Head Start Family Engagement Specialists understand that you are your child's first and most important teacher. They put YOU at the center of your child's learning. Here is what your Family Engagement Specialist will do while working with you and your family:

- 1.) Provide ongoing support to you and your family.
- 2.) Meet with you in your home or in the community throughout the year.
- 3.) Visit your child's classroom weekly.
- 4.) Work closely with your Family Educator and other school personnel.
- 5.) Plan workshops and events.
- 6.) Connect you with community resources.
- 7.) Attend school-related events.
