Early Head Start:

Serves pregnant women and children birth to age three including children with special needs who meet the income and eligibility requirements.

Services available through Community Action Partnership - (402) 471-4515:

- Early Head Start Home-Based:** Weekly year-round home visits and bi-weekly family play groups.
 - Lincoln**
 - Lancaster County** (outside Lincoln city limits)
 - Saunders County**
- Head Start Child Development Center:** 3258 South 13th Street, Lincoln, Nebraska. Hours: 7:30a.m.-5:30p.m., Monday through Thursday, eleven months per year. Serves children ages six weeks to three years. Parents **must** be enrolled for a minimum of **24 hours** (total) in one, or a combination of the following: work, school, job training, GED or ELL courses, or be in a licensed treatment program. Parent transportation is **required**.

Head Start:

Serves children ages three to five including children with special needs who meet the income and eligibility requirements.

Services available through Community Action Partnership - (402) 471-4515:

- Head Start Child Development Center:** 3528 South 13th Street, Lincoln, Nebraska. Hours: 7:30a.m.-5:30p.m., Monday through Thursday, eleven months per year. Serves children ages three to five years. Parents **must** be enrolled for a minimum of **24 hours** (total) in one, or a combination of the following: work, school, job training, GED or ELL courses, or be in a licensed treatment program. Parent transportation is **required**.

Services available through Lincoln Public Schools - (402) 436-1995 :

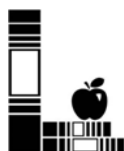
- Part-Day, Part-Year Center-Based:** Children attend a **half-day** center experience in a classroom setting. Bus transportation may be provided to get children to and from E^XCITE/Head Start sites, if needed. Pick up and drop off locations determine which site the children will attend. This program option follows the LPS school calendar.
- Home-Based:** Children and families receive services primarily in their home. The services are provided through weekly home visits and participation in monthly group socialization activities. This program option follows the LPS school calendar.

Services available through Wahoo Public Schools - (402) 443-4250:

- Part-Day, Part-Year:** Children attend a **half-day** center experience in a classroom setting. Bus transportation may be provided to get children to and from Head Start sites. Head Start has center classrooms in Wahoo and Ashland-Greenwood Public Schools. This program option follows the Wahoo and Ashland-Greenwood Public School calendar.
