

These are the three words Daniel, pictured above, used to describe Community Action's Gathering Place.

"Love: I love coming here, and the love is given back," he said. "Joy: I enjoy the meal and the time being here, and Peace: when I leave, I feel peace knowing that I had a good meal."

Daniel is just one of the many guests who has found comfort at the Gathering Place over the years. He began visiting us regularly after he unexpectedly lost his job and experienced homelessness.

You know the importance of the Gathering Place's work to provide free, hot, nutritious meals to any neighbor in need. In the past year, need for this service has skyrocketed. For each of the past six months, we've set new records for the number of meals served at the Gathering Place. Need for our services is growing, and we could not keep up without you.

This October, you helped serve over 5,000 meals to our neighbors experiencing hunger in Lincoln – a Gathering Place record.

And all throughout this fall and winter, you're ensuring that every one of our neighbors has somewhere to enjoy warm, homecooked holiday meals in good company. Because you know, like our guests, that the Gathering Place is so much more than somewhere to eat a meal.

Recently, Daniel shared with us that he has moved into a stable housing situation and found consistent work. He still occasionally visits the Gathering Place, sharing,

"This is a place where I belong." Many of our guests feel the same way.

As you know, the Gathering Place relies primarily on community contributions to operate. We could not do this work without you. You know the importance of accessing healthy food on the journey to economic stability. Thanks to the generous support of this year's lead sponsor, Acklie Charitable Foundation, as well as additional sponsors, gifts to the Gathering Place will be matched \$1 for \$1 through December **31st.** When you give to the Gathering Place this year, your impact will double.

Our goal for this year's campaign is to raise \$200,000 to support the Gathering Place. Currently, you have helped us raise over \$70,000 toward that goal.

Need is greater than ever, and so is your response



Thank you for continuing to ask, "How can I help?" and always stepping up for those we serve.

Dear Friend.

I am always heartened when kind people like you ask me questions like "What are the greatest needs you're seeing in the community right now?" and, shortly thereafter, "How can I help?" The resulting discussion always leads to some kind of action on your part – whether an agreement to do a supply drive, a gift of volunteer service, a donation to one of our campaigns, or another

meaningful contribution.

You are more than someone who cares - you're a true partner in our mission.

If you were to ask me about the most prevalent needs we're seeing right now, two essentials immediately come to mind: food and housing.

At the Gathering Place, we've not even reached the end of 2023 and have already served a record number of meals for a single year. In October alone, that number was over 5,000, 60% more than the same month the prior year. While we might be tempted to believe this increase is the result of word getting out about our great food (our "Taco Tuesday" is becoming a bit legendary in the neighborhood), we know that's not the case. It's because our neighbors' resources aren't stretching as far as they used to. It's because they're hungry and need options.

More folks than ever are reaching out for rent and utility assistance, too. On average, the number of requests we've received this year has increased by nearly **50**% compared to the prior year. Many are doing *all they* can to keep pace with the cost of living right now, and they often do. But none of us are immune from life's curveballs - whether an unexpected medical or car repair bill, job loss, or sudden familial change. And we all need someone to lean on during

these times. So that brings us to a response to the second question, the one I know you're asking as the season of giving approaches: "How can I help?" While there are always many ways to give, there throughout the year. are two that would help us to keep pace with community needs as they exist right now.

The first is to **make a** financial contribution

to the Gathering Place to support our provision of meals not just this holiday season, but throughout the whole year. And thanks to Acklie Charitable Foundation and our additional generous match sponsors, your contribution before the end of the year will be matched \$1 for \$1! The second is to give to our rent and utility

assistance fund, which would provide a bit of additional support to a neighbor who is going through a difficult time. Need for this support will be especially great as we enter the chilly winter months.

Thank you for being a friend to so many in your community through your unwavering support of our work. Wishing you the same joy this holiday season as you bring to us all


