You ensure that no matter what, your neighbors can get the support they need to thrive.

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E very day, we're meeting new neighbors. Community members who have never before needed to ask for support, are coming to us now because of one thing: **They know you will be there** for them. No matter what they need.

At the Gathering Place, for example, you're helping serve more meals than ever before.

This June, the Gathering Place served 4,059 meals. In July, we served 4,359.

This August, we served 4,405 meals at the Gathering Place—the most ever served in a month.

Recently, a new guest, John, shared with us that, "I never needed this place before. But I'm glad you're here now that I do." Need in our community is growing rapidly. It's only because of you that so far, we've been able to meet it. **Thank you.**

But these increased levels of need go beyond the Gathering Place. We are regularly receiving over 1,000 calls for emergency rent, utility, and deposit assistance each month—a level of need greater than the height of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Community Action is one of the largest emergency rent,

utility, and deposit assistance providers in our service area, which makes your support even more critical. By giving to Community Action, you ensure your neighbors like April, can stay safely and stably housed.

Recently, April underwent an emergency surgery and was unable to pay her electricity bill. She faced a utility disconnection as a result. April called Community Action, unsure of where else to turn. April worried she would be released from the hospital to a home without electricity. Thanks to your generosity, we were able to work with April and her utility provider to

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
pay her past-due bill and ensure service was reconnected the following day.

"Thank you," April said, "I'm so grateful that now I can focus on healing."

Dear Friend,

Over my years of working at Community Action, I often experience fleeting and unexpected reminders of my "why." One of these occurred just a few months ago.

I recently had the opportunity to meet with Mara, the mother of one of the infants enrolled in our Head Start program. I knew ahead of time the reason for her visit: to deliver us a donation in appreciation for the service we provided to her family. We do not expect or encourage this, of course, but were happy to accept such a meaningful gift.

I got to share with Mara a little bit more about the plans

we have for our Head Start program, including walking her through the renovations underway at our K Street center. She smiled as I showed her our big new classrooms with lots of windows and connected bathrooms; her eyes widened as I shared where our new activity room would be, with so much space for children to run and play. I've had the opportunity to give this tour many times over the past year; to give it to a parent is a moment I will never forget.

As we were saying our goodbyes, Mara shared with me that she didn't know where she would be without Head Start. With tears in her eyes, she recalled learning that her son was accepted into the program right around Christmas. *It was the best gift she could have received, she said, as it meant she was going to be able to* *continue schooling to get her college degree.* And as we stood there on that day, she'd just come from class.

The impact of Head Start is vast. It eases the financial burden of childcare for parents and caregivers who are working hard toward achieving their goals, like Mara. It provides access to high-quality educational experiences, ensuring children are intellectually, socially, linguistically, and emotionally ready for school. It connects children and families to critical health services from immunizations, to medical, dental and mental health support, to nutritional services, and early development screenings. And it has been proven to result in positive long-term outcomes, from greater high school graduation rates, to increased higher education enrollment and completion rates, to less likelihood to live in poverty, and beyond.

You know the importance of Head Start. It may even be part of your "why." And it is only because of your support, combined with the dollars we receive through our Head Start grant, that this crucial service is available to parents like Mara, and their children, in our community.

Within this newsletter, we've included an update on our Home for Head Start Campaign and renovation of our K Street Center. Thanks to the generosity of donors like you, we have raised 80% of our goal! Just a few more "bricks" are needed to complete our forever home. Julian's mother began implementing these strategies immediately. Recently, she shared some exciting news.

"We were reading Julian's favorite book, The Very Hungry Caterpillar, and he helped me to say the words, 'but he was still hungry. It was so exciting! Hearing my son speak brought me such joy. <u>Thank you</u> for helping us make so much progress."
