On a limited income, she was on a slippery slope towards energy insecurity. Being able to stay began to feel impossible.

Then came hope. Community Action's Weatherization program found the problem. Not a single inch of insulation was in her home. In short order our team actively sealed in warmth, safety, and hope. Katie's bills fell by 30%. As Beau, our Weatherization Program Administrator, says: "Helping someone to stay in their home by breaking the cycle of crippling bills, that's the impact we want."
