### Journey to home

## You support building bridges, strengthening dreams

Couch surfing and moving from one friend's home to another had become Chandra's key to survival. She dreamed of giving her sons a home. She wondered, *What do people do to get their houses?* She knew she needed education and support.

Then Chandra shared her dream with us. She confided in Katie, her Family Advocate within Community Action's Supportive Housing program, her dream to buy a house. With her goal set, things began to click.

You built the bridges Chandra needed to cross to reach her goal. Our Supportive Housing program facilitated a path to rent an apartment and establish credit; gas vouchers to extend a budget; and someone to encourage her when days got hard. Within our Free to Save program Chandra learned about credit, budgeting, mortgages, and more.

Completing Free to Save, Chandra received \$8,000 for her down payment. She added to this a grant from the Ponca Tribe, support from NeighborWorks Lincoln, and a committed realtor. As one community bridge led to another, you were part of a village sustaining a dream.

## Walking TALLER

Your investment in Community Action strengthens our whole community, including the early childhood workforce.

You know that stronger teachers build stronger communities.

Walking a little taller among the Community Action Head Start Zebras, Polar Bears, and Eagles classrooms are Danielle, Justine, and Alex. They're newly certified CDA (Child Development Associate) teachers.

As a friend of Community Action, you value the importance of early childhood education, and the educators who make it possible. That's the magic of our On-the-Job Training program.

"The more I know, the better I can do," said Justine. Yet as a working mom of three, finding time to learn seemed impossible—until On-the-Job Training removed that barrier and others.

A program made possible by a Workforce Development Grant from the City of Lincoln, scholars can study while working at Community Action Head Start. They are also offered financial support to help with living expenses, and receive a laptop to learn when and where they need. They also have a coach on hand to support their success.

Over 83 Head Start teachers have participated in the program so far. They've earned degrees, certifications, and credentials. These advance their careers, lead to higher pay, stronger teaching, and greater stability—for the teachers personally, and for our entire community.

Jenise Kouma

Emergency Services Advocate
Saunders County



"Out here, we have to rely on knowing the lay of the land and working together."

Between Saunders County's 15 communities within 748 square miles, Jenise is a connector. She knows when the Food Bank is in town, where there is a housing opening, and the first names of her partners within the county.

One example of her work: There was a young couple living in their car. They called a lot. Jenise put to work her list of emergency food, housing and job resources, relying on her community trust.

Stable housing led to stable work and ultimately reunification with their child. The more secure these folks became, the less Jenise heard from them.

"And that's the goal," Jenise says.
"Independence, moving forward. They did well."
