The day started normally in the Community Action Head Start pre-school classroom. Hellos and goodbyes were said, breakfast was served, giggles could be heard. And then came a scream that would not end.

Learning to regulate or calm oneself is a skill children must learn. On this morning, this child was not being naughty, bad, or manipulative. He simply did not have the skills he needed to calm himself.

The reason why is not as important as the response. And **Head Start is skilled at knowing how to respond.**

Thanks to you, at Community Action we have embedded mental health expertise into our systems and leadership.

Alexa Ewbank is Head Start's Mental Health Consultant. With over 400 children and parents, it is neither feasible nor best practice for Alexa to work one-on-one with each family. What Alexa does is **build the capacity of our caregivers and parent educators** by providing informed mental health-based observation, training, guidance and resources.

With your support, Community Action Head Start teachers are then strengthened to nurture emotional abilities so children are ready to learn. Head Start parent educators are prepared to support and assist parents in developing needed skills. **A head start into life is being uplifted for the entire family.**

Back in the classroom, the Head Start teacher uses her training. Face-to-face with the bereft student, she uses a calm and reassuring voice, and offers him visual cues so he can communicate without words.

Working together, the day is ready to begin. Thank you.

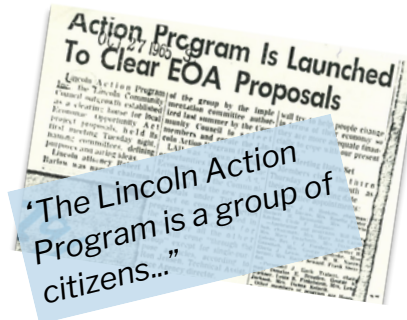
Celebrating 60 years is an opportunity to reflect, to look forward, to dream big, and to set new goals.
